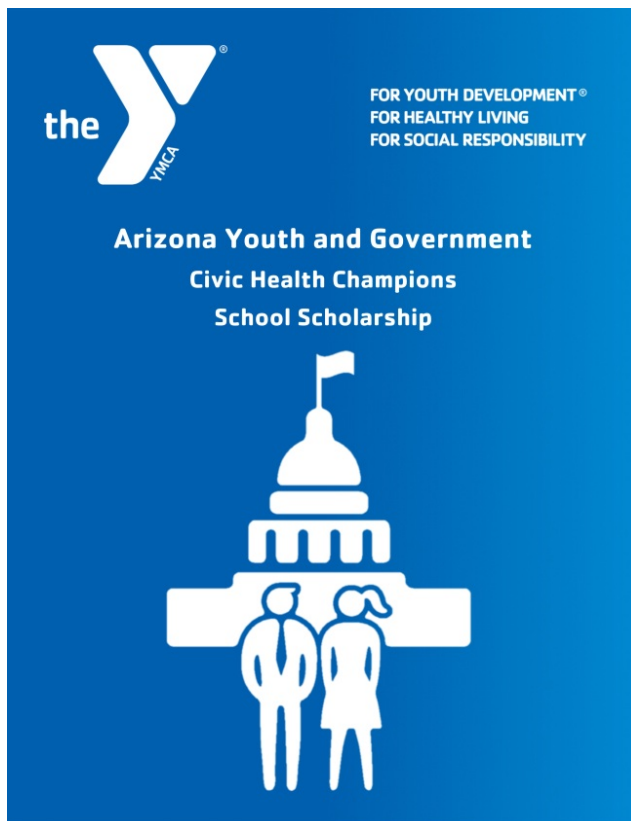

The Valley of The Sun YMCA is excited to share an opportunity for your school to become involved with our Youth & Government program.

We are offering a school scholarship and teacher stipend for 16 middle and high schools here in AZ to participate!

This is a national program in 42 states that encourages civic engagement, civil discourse, and leadership. At the heart of the program is the belief that “democracy must be learned by each generation” and this hands-on program is a proven way to develop tomorrow’s leaders.

This semester-long program is hosted through a “club”

environment at local schools or YMCAs through meetings. It comes with full curriculum and included statewide delegation meetings that leads students through topics such as parliamentary procedure, political parties, the media, voting, bill writing and debate policy. The semester concludes with the Model Legislature & Court Conference held each year during the first weekend in December at the Arizona State Capitol.

During this capstone experience students debate their bills in the State House and Senate, run for office, write a daily newspaper and host State Supreme Court hearings. The Program is open to all Arizona students from 6-12 grade.
