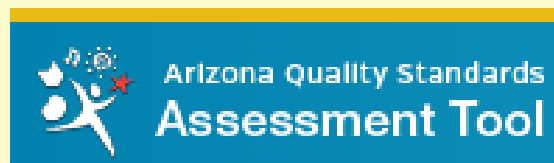
Grant Opportunities for Arizona Youth Programs
