Accepting STEM Grant Applications Now!



The Arizona Center for Afterschool Excellence and Cox Communications invite Arizona out-of-school time programs to apply for grants to create new or expanded ways to incorporate Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM) learning in out-of-school time programming. Nearly 80% of future careers will require some STEM skills. Out-of-school time programs are uniquely positioned to support STEM learning through hands-on, project-based activities that expand on concepts from the school day.

Grants will range in value from \$500 to \$1,500 with a total of \$10,000 available to be awarded. Out-of-school programs serving 6 to 18 year olds are eligible to apply and must submit a grant application with a full description and budget of their planned use for the funds by Friday, April 28. Grant applications must describe how the project funding will be used and the educational benefits derived. Grants will be awarded statewide to programs based on their creativity and innovation in connecting youth to real-world STEM issues.
