The cycle is open for out-of-school time professionals in the middle of their career to apply for the National Afterschool Matters (NASM) Fellowship! The Fellowship is a **two-year leadership development program** that better positions participants to inform and contribute to the quality of out-of-school-time programs, practice, and the field.



The Fellowship includes a **collaborative process of study and engagement** in OST practice, policy, and experiences; direct, hands-on inquiry-based research and more under the **guidance of experienced mentors**; **leadership development**; information dissemination in professional publications and appearances; **two retreats** at Wellesley College, led by NIOST and NWP (travel stipend provided); and a **participation stipend** each year.
