As OST providers, we are often asked by funders and partners about the benefits of our programs to the students who engage in them. This report from <u>2021 from the</u> <u>Afterschool Alliance</u> presents data that demonstrates the positive impacts afterschool programming has on children and youth.

We were particularly impressed by the data around participation in summer programs positively impacting school-year outcomes. Specifically, "A 2020 quasiexperimental study of the Aim High summer program found that program participation resulted in significant benefits during the school year, including a 22 percent reduction in chronic absenteeism, a 37 percent reduction in suspension rates, and a 6-point improvement in English language art scores. " That's an incredible impact!
