Calling All Youth Programs To Participate in Pilot Program

AzCASE invites out-of-school time programs statewide to sign up one or multiple sites to "pilot" of the new **Arizona Out-of-School Time Quality Assessment Tool** when it is rolled out later this fall.

The **Assessment Tool** is designed and intended to allow OST programs to voluntarily and confidentially measure their quality against the Arizona Quality

Standards for Out-of-School Time Programs.

150 program sites are needed to test the reliability of this new tool.

To be eligible to be a test site, programs must:

- be an AZ based out-of-school time program, serving youth afterschool, during the summer, and/or on school breaks
- serve youth between the ages of 8-15
- be able to assign a different staff member at each site to serve as an "evaluator" for the pilot

Sites volunteering will be given free copies of the Arizona OST Quality Assessment Tool and instructions on how to use the tool. Then, they will turn in test results to AzCASE for scoring by the tool designer. Scores will be confidential and only shared with the designated contact person at each program. Scores of the individual pilot test sites will **NOT** be publicly posted.
